A three shot par 5. Place your tee shot as close to the left edge of the fairway as you dare. The second shot should be hit to the upper plateau. The elevated green position may require an additional club. A ridge running down the center of the green separates the right and left sides.

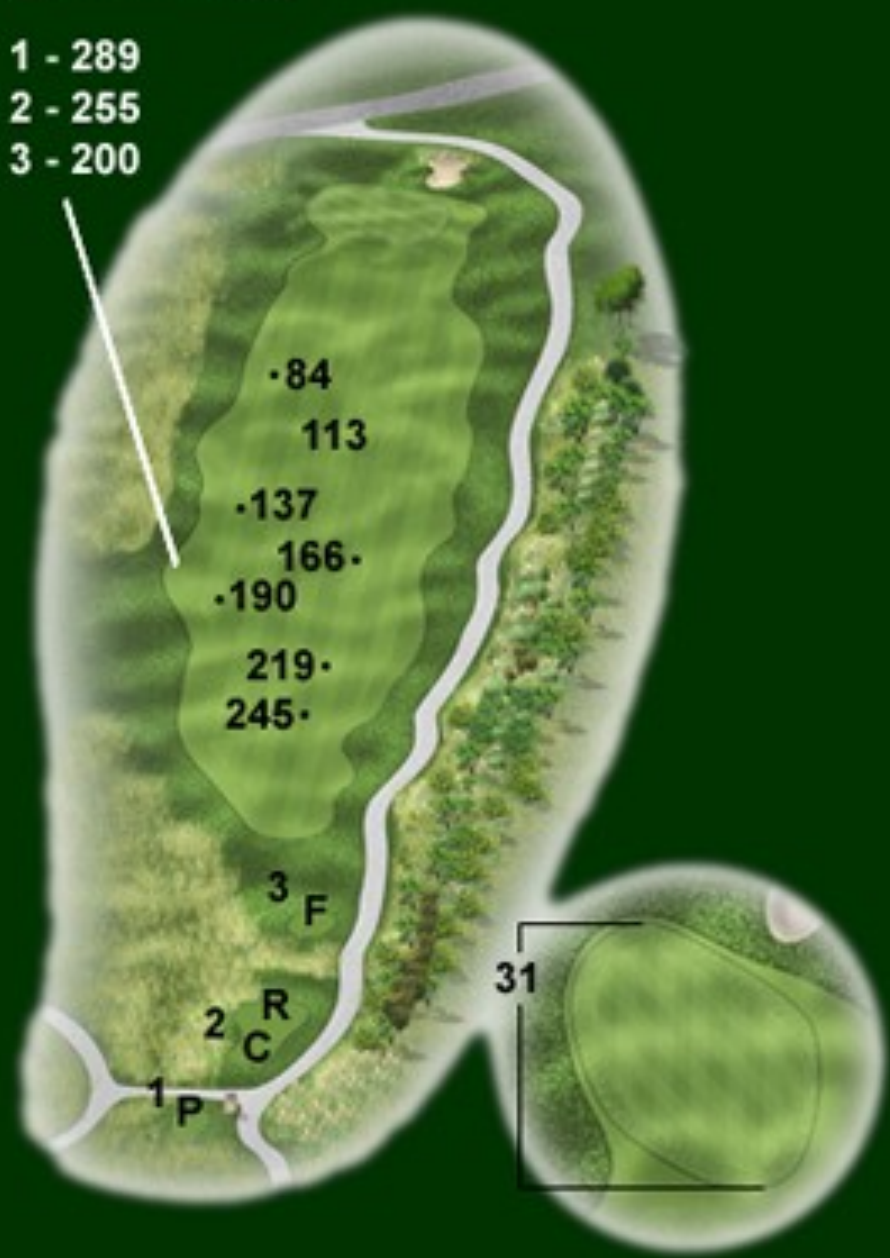


Favor the right side of the fairway on your tee shot. The entire fairway slopes left. The approach shot needs to carry the front edge of this narrow, two-tiered green. Beware of this green's false front.

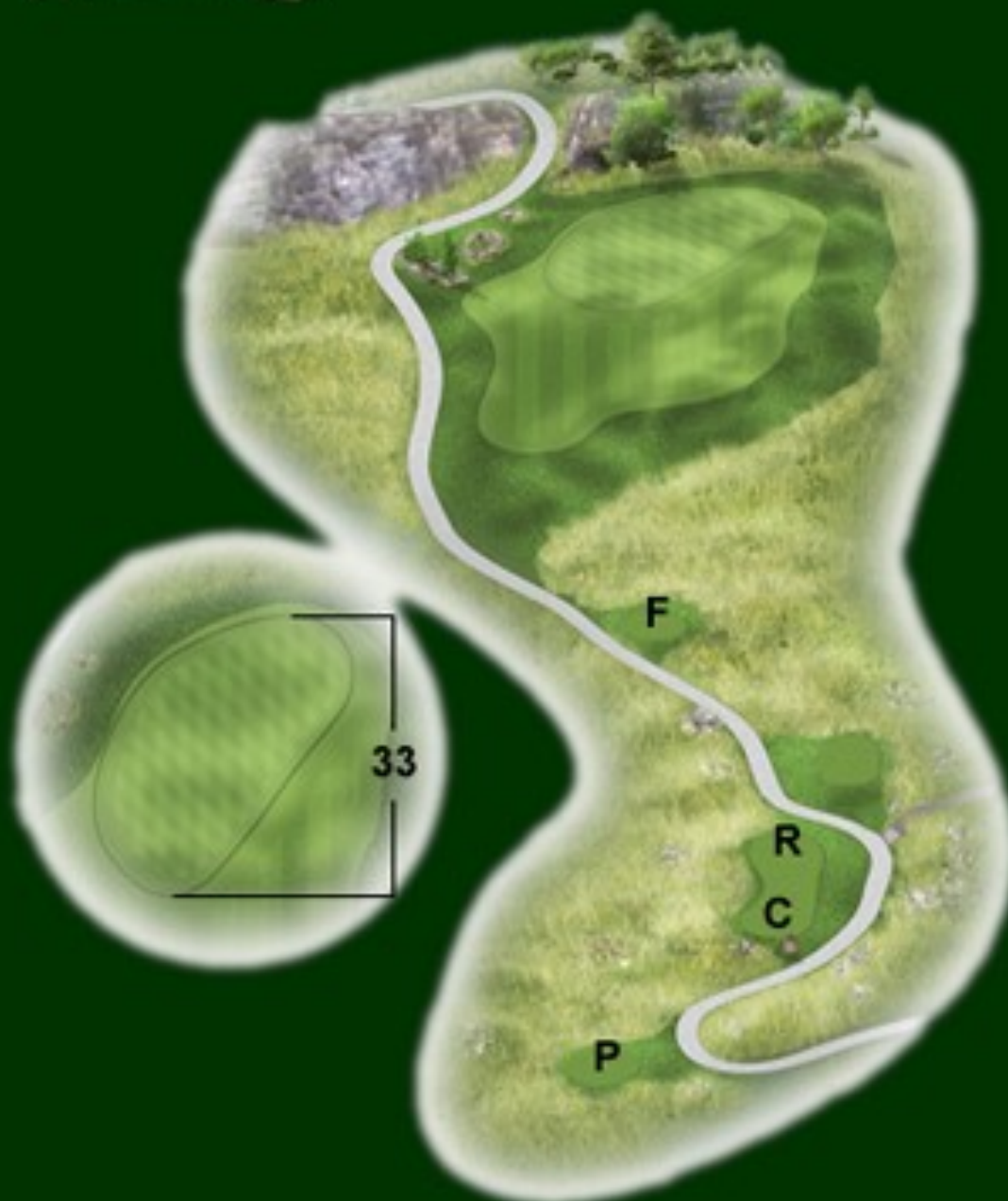
